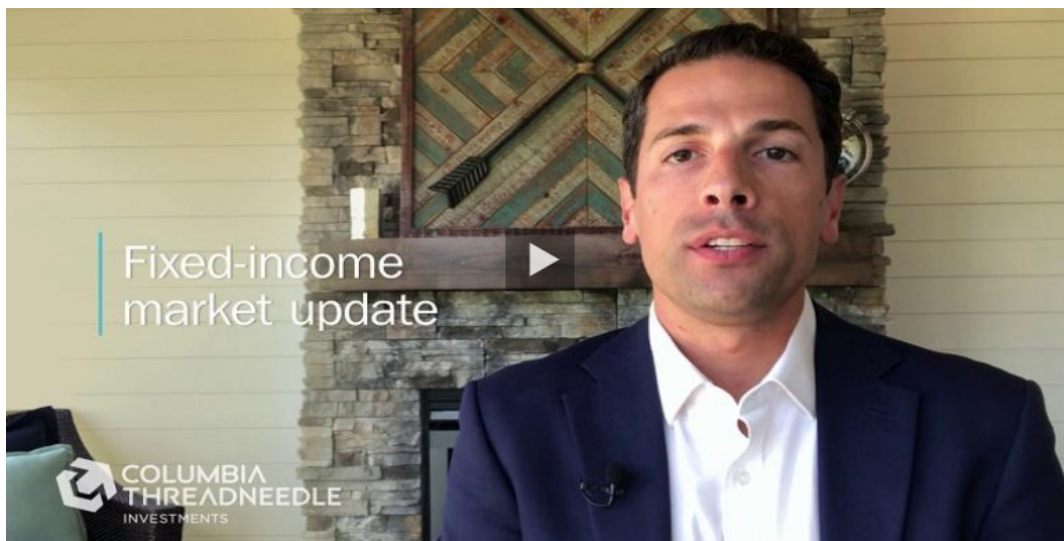


Fixed-income market update

Given that rates will likely be very low for an extended period of time, where can bond investors look for income?
